FFOP hosts a series of regional workshops providing training to participants as well as a forum for religious leaders to constructively engage with top environmental actors and policy makers. Our aim is to identify and design engagement methods, including communication and community mobilization strategies for each region..

Youth Fellowship Program

We select 30 to 50 aspiring faith leaders for a week-long residential program held at a leading higher education institution. During the fellowship program, these youth leaders are trained in climate science, communication, and media literacy by a panel of renowned academics.

Global Interfaith Summit

This monumental event focuses on addressing the obstacles hindering the mobilization of faith communities' participation in climate action, including the existing rift between religious and scientific communities. The summit drives high-profile dialogue between these groups, providing faith communities with tangible solutions to tackle the most pressing environmental challenges facing their communities.
